SCOPE

VoC PROGRAMME

In December 2015, January 2016 and March 2022 the ministry of trade issued decrees 991/2015, 992/2015, 43/2016, 44/2019 and 96/2022 introducing list of products (refer to the datasheet) into the Verification of Conformity program and mandating a manufacturer (along related factories) registration process with GOEIC (General Organization for Export and Import Control).

The Conformity program is managed by the Ministry of Trade and Industry and is implemented by GOEIC. GOEIC recognizes Bureau Veritas Verification certificates issued specifically for this program. This recognition has been made official on GOEIC web site and confirmed by an official letter declaring that Bureau Veritas is accepted and registered as Inspection body that can assess the conformity of goods against the applicable Egyptian standards and issue certificate of inspection (Upon satisfactory VoC process).

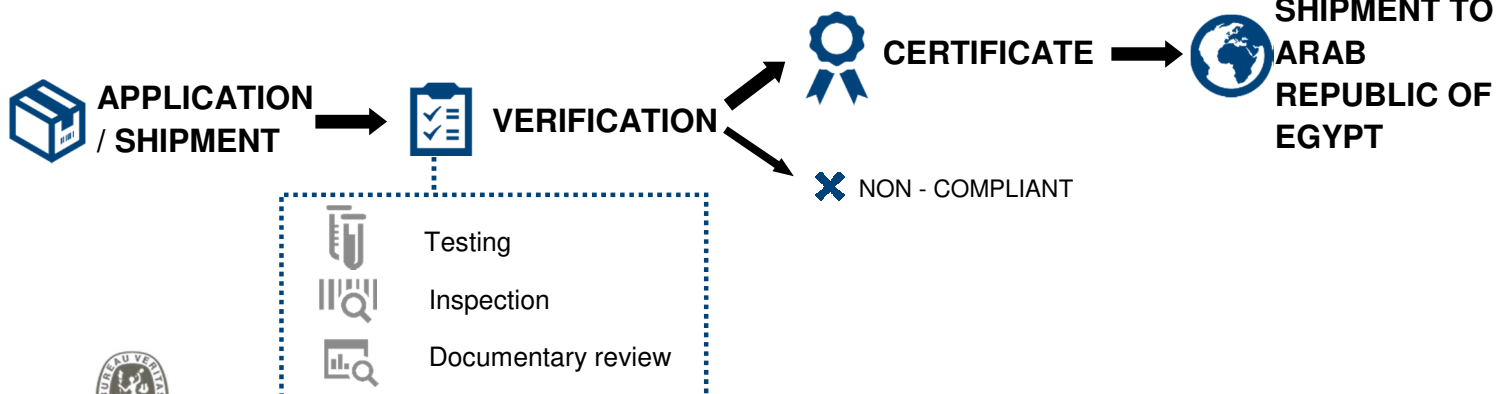

BASIC PROCESS OVERVIEW





PROCESS

Step 1 : Request for Certificate

Importer / Exporter lodges a Request for Certificate to a Bureau Veritas local contact. Said request should include:

- List, HS Code, designation of goods intended to be exported, importer / exporter details (name, address, invoice, ...)
- Conformity documents available (ex: Third party certificate, Test reports, Reports of analysis, quality management system certificates...)
- Information related to local and provisional date of availability of goods to carry out their inspection before shipment. (Filling up of the Request For Certificate (RFC) Form)

Step 2 : Documentary review / Testing

Bureau Veritas reviews all information provided and checks their adequacy against the Egyptian standards. Laboratory testing / analysis are conducted on samples if necessary.

Step 3 : Inspection

Bureau Veritas checks that:

- Products comply with applicable standards
- Goods presented are those identified during the documentary review
- Goods match their description in the import / export documents
- If necessary, Bureau Veritas inspectors may take samples for additional assessment.

Step 4 : Certificate of Inspection

Bureau Veritas checks the inspection report against the provided documents. Upon satisfactory results, a secured Certificate of Inspection is issued; else, a Non-Conformity Report is produced. Exporters are recommended not to ship their goods prior issuance of the required Certificate.
